

EARLY ACTION ACTIVITY (EAA)

South Union Street Bridge Lighting



As a condition of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Choice Neighborhoods Initiative (CNI) planning grant, the Montgomery Housing Authority (MHA) is required to implement an Early Action Activity (EAA, which will benefit residents of the community. After consulting with our partners and residents, MHA's plan is for the installation of bridge lighting beneath the Union Street overpass along I85 at the north end of Paterson Court. The MHA has secured over \$200,000 for the development of the EAA and is projected to be completed by the fall of 2022.

The Union Street EAA will fulfill the resident's needs of lighting (which is something residents highlighted when MHA was originally developing an EAA project) thus increasing safety and walkability.
